Honoring the Legacy of St. Francis Hospital's First Baby

John Henry Felix, a respected leader and philanthropist, holds a unique place in the history of St. Francis Healthcare System as the first baby born at St. Francis Hospital. His life has been one of extraordinary service and achievement. A former Honolulu City Councilmember, diplomat, and business executive, John Henry dedicated his life to public service and global community betterment.



He remained closely connected to St. Francis, serving as a valued board member and championing its mission of compassionate care. In recognition of his lifelong commitment to the community and the values of St. Francis, he was honored with the prestigious St. Francis of Assisi Award. John Henry's legacy is woven into the fabric of Hawai'i; his vision, generosity, and dedication to others have left a lasting impact on health care, education, and civic life across the islands.

On May 5th, John Henry passed away under the care of St. Francis Home Hospice. We are honored to have been in so many chapters of John Henry's extraordinary life.



St. Francis, deeply rooted in the legacy of the Sisters of St. Francis, continues to uphold the values and mission that have guided it since its inception. St. Francis Hospice offers a multi-disciplinary team of medical staff, spiritual staff, and social workers dedicated to supporting patients and their families during this chapter of life.



Our Hospice Bereavement Team supports family and friends who are in their journey of grief for a full year after the passing of their loved one.

Recognizing that grief can be an isolating experience where social connection is missing, St. Francis Hospice Bereavement Social Workers Monica Bailey-Jubé and Kelly Acuña developed the Grief Café, a casual social environment where grievers can connect in shared experiences and find strength in collective.

In October, family and friends from St. Francis' Hospice program and the community at large joined our annual Rose for Remembrance, an interdenominational celebration of life.

CARE NAVIGATION

Bringing Support to Caregivers and Families

Our Care Navigation program pairs one of our licensed social workers with families with a loved one who needs help navigating the complex and fragmented healthcare system. In the past 12 months, this program has served over 150 kūpuna and their families. We help these families find appropriate resources when they are experiencing a high level of stress and uncertainty. Although this is a valuable service, care coordination is not currently covered by health insurance and is provided to families free of cost by St. Francis.
